Online counselling on 5th & 6th November, 2020

Please read the instructions carefully

1. Online counselling will be held on 5th and 6th November, 2020, for admission in M.Sc. I (H. S.) in Physics, M.Sc. I (H. S.) in Physics (specialization in Electronics) and M.Sc. I in Medical Physics for the batch 2020-21.
2. Based on the provisional merit list, uploaded by the Computer Center on 2nd November, 2020, the online counselling of the **top Approved** “Overall” merit list candidates with “Overall (total) Marks up to **2050**” will be conducted. The **Overall marks** are mentioned in the column prior to the “Pref. 1” column.
3. Further, the counselling of all the Approved category candidate cases (BC, SC, ST, OGC, RAS, BAS, FF, DEF, etc.) will be also carried out.
4. The above-mentioned candidates (#2 and #3) are invited by systematically assigning the google meet identity numbers and timings in a batch-wise manner. Please check the associated **Counselling** file.
5. The invited students must join the Google Meet group at the beginning of the allotted time and leave the group after their counselling. This will be the preferred mode. We will not make any change in the time schedule.
6. As an alternative, the candidate must also be prepared for Whatsapp communication in case the situation arises, with the same mobile number as provided in the Application form.
7. The candidate must practice with a friend on the two modes to show their documents and face using the Google Meet link and Whatsapp video link.
8. A single counselling is sufficient even if a candidate has applied for several categories.
9. The merit lists and the waiting lists for all the categories, and the three courses, will be prepared separately. It will be posted on Physics Department web-site after approval from DUI.
10. We request all the students to avoid unnecessary email communications, specially emails related with acknowledgements, thanks, un-reasonable requests, etc. Visit the Physics Department web-site routinely. Information will be conveyed there.
